Well Child Health Reports for 6th and 8th Grade Students

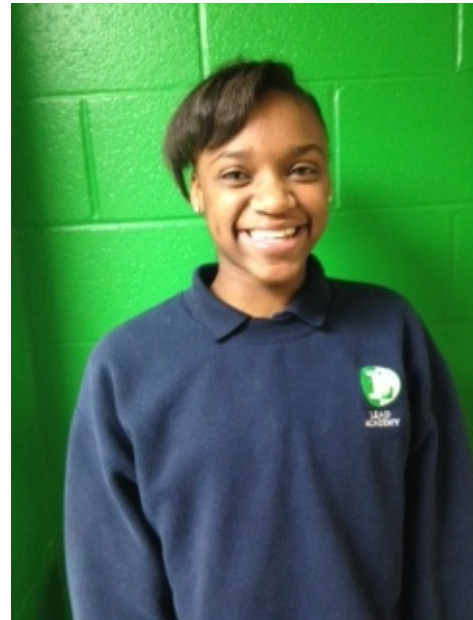
