### **Well Child Health Reports for 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students**

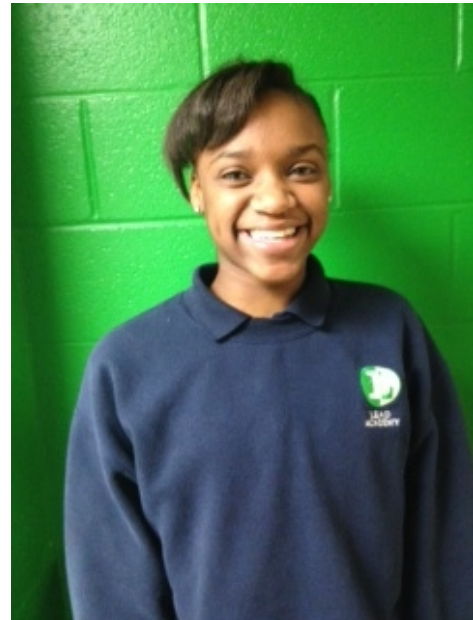
